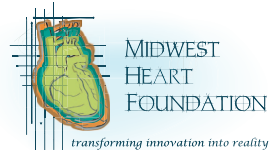

# Interpreting Screening ECGs in Young Adults A LIVE WEBINAR

Sudden Cardiac Death (SCD) tragically strikes more than 30 young adults each week in the US. In response to this problem, ECG screenings have been proposed.
